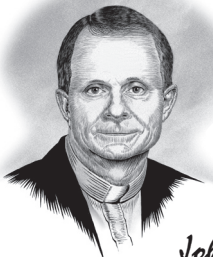

Know This...

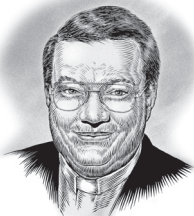

John: Satan and the other fallen angels are spiritual beings; and like us, they have intellect and free will.



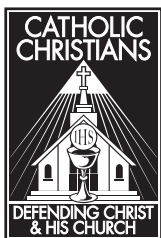

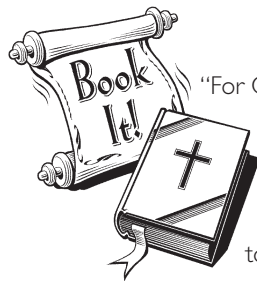
"The devil and the other demons were indeed created naturally good by God, but they became evil by their own doing."
