Does God Condone Cloning & Stem Cell Use?

Know This...

Medical and scientific discoveries amaze us. Our knowledge and understanding today of things once unknown far exceed that of ten years ago. While we're amazed, God is not. What we praise as discovery, He fixed in the beginning. This is why the Church is able to teach with certainty whether or not medical and scientific discoveries are ethical and moral. God, through His Church, says human cloning and embryonic stem cell research are always intrinsically evil; but adult stem cell research is good.



John: The cell is the basic building block of all plant and animal life. A stem cell is basically an early "blank" cell capable of becoming a specific cell; such as a skin or muscle cell.

James: Embryonic stem cells are harvested from week-old human embryos. The embryo (innocent life) is destroyed when these stem cells are removed.



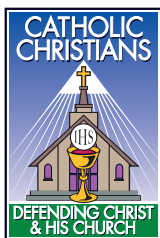
John: Adult stem cells naturally exist in our bodies. They can be harvested safely from a baby's umbilical cord and placenta, as well as from skin, muscle, bone marrow, etc. Research and treatment using adult stem cells never destroys human life.

James: Cloning—artificially conceiving a human being—is always wrong, whether to produce children or for research. One moves procreation to the laboratory; the other produces an identical twin only to harvest his tissues, organs, and cells.

John: Embryonic stem cell research destroys innocent life. It's intrinsically evil. Adult stem cell research can heal and save lives without destroying life.

"There are two ways: a way of life and a way of death. There is a great difference between them... In accordance with the precept of the teaching: you shall not kill... You shall not put a child to death

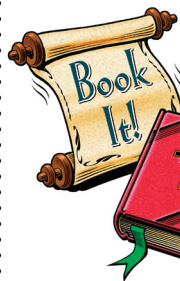
