Confirmation Seals The Baptized With What Gifts?

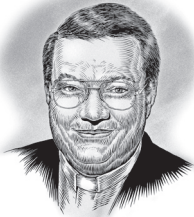
Know This...

When Jesus ascended into heaven, He sent the Holy Spirit into His Church and our lives to strengthen and lead us into the light of truth. Satan and the allure of this world are no match for the infinite power of the Holy Spirit dwelling in the faithful. The sacrament of Confirmation seals the baptized with the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. These gifts equip us to participate in the worship and apostolic life of the Church.



John: Confirmation completes and perfects the grace we received at Baptism, unites us more firmly to Christ, and strengthens our bond with His Church.

James: Confirmation draws us into the mission of the Church and gives us the courage to bear witness to our Christian faith through acts of charity.



John: Like Baptism and Holy Orders, Confirmation places an indelible mark on the soul of the baptized.

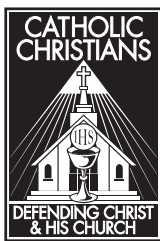
James: Only Baptism and Confession can wash away mortal sin; so the confirmed must be free of mortal sin for the sacrament to bring forth grace.

John: If one is confirmed while in a state of mortal sin, sacramental grace will not enter the soul until the guilt of mortal sin is absolved in Confession.

James: Confirmation prepares us for spiritual warfare, just as it prepared the Apostles and early Christians who risked their lives to preach and practice the faith.

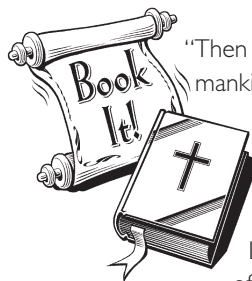
