

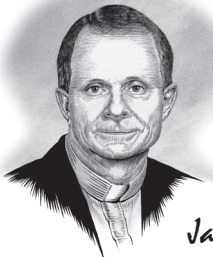

Who Has The Right To End A Human Life?

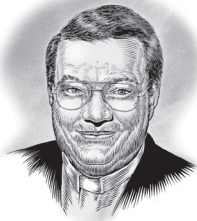
Know This...

God has a plan for each of us. He doesn't disclose it quickly, but reveals it over our lifetime. Unfortunately, pride and impatience often lead us to think we know God's plan; and so we often walk the wrong path and fail to fulfill His will. God willed the moment of our conception; and He alone has the right to will the moment of our natural death. When someone intervenes to end a life, even the life of someone who is suffering, God's will is derailed. Euthanasia, incorrectly called 'mercy killing', is always intrinsically evil and morally wrong.



James: But our prayers, open to

God's will, never go unanswered. In fact, God permits suffering to draw us into prayer. When we pray, we open ourselves to God's plan.



John: God knows it's difficult for us to watch a loved one suffer. We feel helpless; especially, when it seems our prayers go unanswered.

John: Euthanasia is "An action or an omission which, of itself or by intention, causes the death of handicapped, sick, or dying persons." (CCC)

James: It violates the fifth commandment: 'Thou shall not kill.' Life is a precious gift from God. It is His to give and His alone to end.

John: The Church does not demand that life be prolonged at all cost. The dying may refuse aggressive, extraordinary treatment when death is imminent.

James: However, a misguided attempt to show mercy and end suffering by ending a life is murder and is always forbidden.

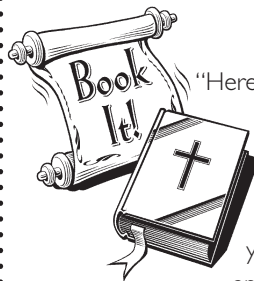
Jesus said, "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, 'You shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment.'" Mt. 5:21

PAPA SAYS

"[Today] death is considered 'senseless' if it suddenly interrupts a life still open to a future of new and interesting experience. But it becomes a 'rightful liberation' once life is held to be no longer meaningful because it is filled with pain and inexorably doomed to even greater suffering... In harmony with the Magisterium of my Predecessors and in communion with the bishops of the Catholic Church, I confirm that euthanasia is a grave violation of the law of God, since it is the deliberate and morally unacceptable killing of a human person." Pope John Paul II
